

Guide for Conference Venues

Getting Here

The MDAI conference will be held at Meiji University Nakano Campus. Nakano is a city in Tokyo, nearby Shinjuku - a 5-minute train (JR Chuo line) ride from Shinjuku. A train comes almost every 5 minute. All trains stop Nakano station. So, you don't have to worry about choice of train.

Use the north exit and ride on a small escalator to the sidewalk toward the campus. The station and the area are under construction these days. You may find people walking to the park (Nakano Shiki-no-Mori park) and follow them about 8 minutes to our campus. We suggest to walk in the building (Central park south) so that you can avoid a sunshine.



Meeting Rooms

All sessions will be held in Room #515 and #516. It is on the fifth floor. Campus building open for any visitors, and you just enter from the central entrance. (No need to stop by guard)

Ride in the lift (on your left) to the fifth floor. The rooms are in the end of the hallway.



Lunch and Coffee

Lunch will be provided from 6^{th} floor, room called "presentation space" in 28^{th} and 29^{th} and in the cafeteria in the first floor in 30^{th} . Use stairs to the 6^{th} floor.

Coffee and refreshments are also available in the presentation space (6th floor). Note that the presentation space is open area. Since it is summer vacation and presumably no student comes to campus, we don't have any partition to divide the space. (If you meet any student, they must be very good ones because they love school very well. Try to talk to them to enjoy.)

Note that there are two TOKYU hotels in Kichijoji (Excel hotel Tokyu and Tokyu Rei Hotel). After the dinner, we don't provide a bus. Please walk to the station and go back to your hotel by your own. (We considered several options, but it is hard to cover all hotels. Trains are mostly better option than bus in Tokyo.)

From Kichijoji station, there are 6 stops to Shinjuku, taking about 15 minutes.
